RETRAINING AND RECRUITING CANDIDATES

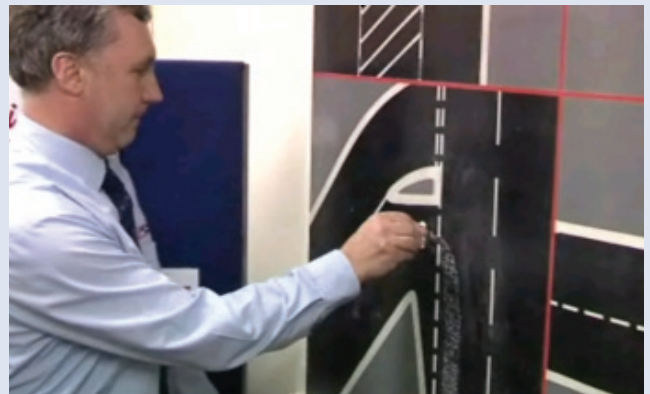
